Nine Tests to Prove if it's Love

READ TEXT: John 15:8-22.

Nine Tests to Prove if it's Love:

1. Does it obey God's commands or violate them? (v.10)
2. Is it joyful in God? (v.11)
3. Does it reflect Jesus? (v.12)
4. Is it for the other, or selfish? (v.13)
5. Does it have the ring of true friendship? (13-15)
6. Does it take the glory for itself, or give it to God? (8, 15-16)
7. Is it for a purpose higher than itself? (v.16)
8. Is it willing to suffer? (18)
9. Does it speak the truth, regardless of the culture and popularity? (22)

1. This love is the essential Christian ingredient. How do you handle people who claim to be Christians but exhibit no attributes of love?

2. With these qualities of love in mind, how is your Christianity?

3. Do you feel more like Jesus' servant or friend?

4. As a branch on Christ's tree, what kind of branch are you? (Context of 15:1-7) (Strong? Fruitful? Wormy? Green and growing? Diseased? Dry? Why?

5. How would you rate yourself in laying down your life for your friends?
